- Licensed and ordained in the Baptist church, in accordance with the Baptist Doctrine and procedures.
- Ordained Minister with at least five years of verifiable Baptist Church experience in ministry and ministerial leadership
- Four-year college graduate or enrolled in an accredited institution (preferred)
- Possess a Masters of Divinity or Masters of Theology degree from an accredited institution (preferred)
- Effective communicator, oral and written.
- Commit fully to and support the vision, mission, and policies of the church
- Demonstrate a commitment to excellence in preaching, teaching, pastoral care, community outreach and organizational leadership.
- Counseling experience and training
- Demonstrate a knowledge of civic issues and an understanding of public sector processes and policies. Represent and participate in community wellness.
